## Website Manual

### 1. Getting started

When you open the [dentaedu.tv](http://dentaedu.tv) site you are greeted by the founder Dr. Bradley Engle. By skipping the introduction you could choose to view the displayed sample videos.

The video will load by showing the percentage of buffering and then it will play automatically in progressive download mode.

If you have a fast enough connection to the internet you can switch to Streaming Video Mode.

You have the option to view the movie full screen by clicking on the full screen button.

If your connection speed is too slow for the HD option click on the button "HD Mode" to turn it off. This allows you to see the movie at a lower resolution with video stutter less likely in HD Mode is off.

When the sample comes to the end the page returns to its original state. You could choose any other video by clicking on the samples at the right of the screen.

To see all the courses DentalEDU.tv offers, go to the menu "Available Courses".

The courses are divided in categories. After selecting a category of your choice you will see all available courses with their descriptions and samples.

In order to buy a course you need to be registered as a user.

Free courses you can find in the category “Free Courses” and also their pertaining categories. They are not priced, but you always need to be registered as a user to watch them.

Please register and fill out the form of all required data and be sure that you don’t leave any mandatory textbox blank that has an asterisk next to it.

Please check the states where you are certified in.

Create your own password and click complete registration. Input the number of your license or multiple licenses.

Clicking on continue will terminate successfully your registration process, and you will be redirected automatically on the “Available Courses” webpage.

## 2. HD Video Player

To view the first chapter, please click on the number 1 next to chapters.  
To view the second chapter, please click on the number 2 next to chapters  
and for number, etc.

Click pause to stop and click play to continue.

By clicking in the timeline you can access any point in the chapter when  
streaming mode is on. Otherwise, in the progressive download mode you  
can access any point in the chapter that is already preloaded.

Click on the volume button to decrease or increase the volume.

If you have insufficient bandwidth to play your movie smoothly leave the  
full screen view of the player and click on the "HD Mode" button and  
switch to "HD Mode is off". The movie will restart from the beginning of  
the chapter using a smaller bit rate.

If you click the "HD Mode" button again then you will turn it back on. The  
movie will restart from the beginning of the chapter in High Definition.

Generally we recommend that you use the streaming video option. If the  
movie stutters then you could switch the "Streaming Mode" button to  
non-streaming mode (Progressive Download Mode).

### **3. Course Menu**

Please click on the “Show Course Menu” button in the lower left the control bar area of the video player.

The course menu panel will pop up. If your video player is in “Full Screen Mode” you will not be able to input any data.

So please make sure that you exit the full screen view of the movie before.

Click on review course objectives to go through the complete list of subjects taught in this course.

To ask a question to the instructor, please click on “Ask Instructor a Question”. Type in the question you want to ask and click send.

If the instructor is online during a live lecture or surgery your question may be elected to be answered on the live program. If not then an answer by the instructor will be sent as an email after the lecture is completed.

The same goes for questions you input while watching a video on demand. To submit your question, please click on send.

If you want to write down notes and reminders for yourself you can do so with the course notes button.

You write your note and send it. Now you can review your own course notes at any later date. This is a very handy way of reminding you of cross references or more in depth investigations you would like to do. Click “Send” to save it.
